Box 32180, Oklahoma City, OK 73123 along with the final payment of \$\_\_\_\_\_ due 2 weeks prior to attending.

The counselors are college students and high school juniors and seniors who love camp! All camp staff members are screened and have completed the Archdiocesan Safe Environment Training. You will have a chance to meet the counselors when you drive your child to camp. Joining us during camp to share their faith will be priests, seminarians, young adults and adults who work with youth who are also screened and trained in Safe Environment.

Our mission is to nurture positive Catholic values in young people, to provide campers a community of faith and fun in a safe environment and to develop their prayer life, social skills, independence and respect for others. To help us accomplish this, **please do not let your child bring any electronics to camp including cell phones.** We want them to enjoy the outdoor environment and develop healthy relationships with other youth their age. **Please bring their mail (Please, no food or snacks.) from you to camp. ## Map & Directions to Camp



- Camp gates open at 5 pm on Sunday. Check-in is from 5:00-6:00 pm.
- Campers are not allowed to leave the camp and return during their camping session.
- **Check-out time is on Friday** from **4:00-5:00 pm.**
- Campers need written permission to leave with someone other than a parent/guardian.
- Cabins are assigned and cabin mates are requested at check-in.
- **Reminder:** Cell phones, Laptops, DVD players, TVs, IPODS, electronic games, etc. are not allowed at camp.
- All meals and snacks, including supper on Sunday, are provided by the camp. Please do not send snacks to camp. (3 meals & 2 snacks provided)
- If you need to reach your child, please call the Youth Office 405.721.9220.
- For emergencies, call 405.990.0210 or 405.990.0145.
- **Visitors or phone calls to campers are not allowed. If you need to speak with the director call 405 277 4383.**

From Interstate 35, take Exit 141 and go east 16½ miles on Highway 66. Turn north on Pottawatomie Road and go 3½ miles. The campsite is on the east side of the road. There's an OLOG sign.

Traveling west on the Turner Turnpike, take the Wellston Exit 158 and go 5.6 miles west on Highway 66 to Pottawatomie Road.
