

Camp Information

SUNDAY CHECK-IN LIST

- ◆ Arrive at the campsite between 5–6:00 PM.
- ◆ Check-in at the Dining Hall.
- ◆ Check-in all prescription medicine in original containers at the First Aid Station. The camp will provide over the counter medications.
- ◆ Meet your camper's counselors and the camp staff.
- ◆ Please leave mail items (no food) in Dining Hall.
- ◆ Take camper's luggage to their cabin.
- ◆ Help your camper settle into their cabin and say goodbye.

FRIDAY CHECK-OUT LIST

- ◆ Arrive at OLOG between 4 –5:00 PM on Friday.
- ◆ Check-in with camp office staff to pick up camper.
- ◆ Anyone under 18 years of age will need written permission to leave with someone other than a parent/guardian.
- ◆ Collect all your camper's luggage and belongings. Check the Lost and Found area.

Parents or guardians will be notified in the event of the following incidents:

- Your camper becomes seriously ill or injured and require a doctor's attention.
- Your camper experiences excessive homesickness.
- Your camper exhibits continuous disruptive behavior.

Cell phones, Laptops, DVD players, TVs, video IPODS, electronic games of any kind are not allowed at camp. If found, these items will be held in the camp office until the end of a camper's session. Our Lady of Guadalupe Catholic Camp does not tolerate alcohol, drugs, tobacco or weapons, including Swiss Army

CAMPER'S PACKING LIST

Well-labeled, familiar clothes and items help campers return home with all of their belongings.

The camp will provide bug spray & sunscreen.

- ◆ A pair of tennis shoes (very important)
- ◆ 5 pairs of shorts
- ◆ 1 pair of jeans
- ◆ 5 t-shirts
- ◆ 5 pairs of underwear & socks
- ◆ Pajamas or sleepwear
- ◆ Long sleeved shirt
- ◆ Swim suit (modest one-piece swim suit or 2 piece that looks like a one-piece for girls)
- ◆ Sleeping bag or twin size sheets & blanket
- ◆ Pillow
- ◆ Two bath towels & wash cloth
- ◆ Beach towel
- ◆ Personal hygiene items (soap, shampoo, toothbrush, etc.)
- ◆ Shower shoes (flip flops)
- ◆ White t-shirt or visor (for arts and crafts)
- ◆ Flashlight with batteries
- ◆ Laundry bag or plastic bag (for dirty clothes)
- ◆ Prescription medicine in original containers
- ◆ Disposable camera (optional)

Please do not send food. We are trying to keep the cabins as insect/critter free as possible. If snacks are found, the counselor will turn them in to the kitchen supervisor to be shared by all.

Our Lady of Guadalupe Catholic Camp is NOT responsible for items left at the campsite. Unclaimed lost and found items will be donated to charity by August 20, 2010.
